Rise in number of deaths since mid-January

Vienna, 2022-02-03 – According to preliminary results by Statistics Austria, a total of 1 810 persons died in the third calendar week of 2022 (17 to 23 January 2022), which is 140 more than in the previous week.

"In the third calendar week of 2022, more people died in Austria compared to the two weeks before. With 1 810 deaths between 17 and 23 January 2022, the number of deaths was 1.8% higher than the average for the third calendar week of the pre-Corona period. Compared to the corresponding calendar week of the previous year, however, we see a decline in deaths of around 10%," says Statistics Austria Director General Tobias Thomas.
