# Tourist winter season 2021/22 closed with 52.7 million nights spent

Vienna, 2022-06-01 – According to preliminary results from Statistics Austria, 52.66 million **nights spent** were registered in Austrian accommodation establishments in the **winter tourism season 2021/22** from November 2021 to April 2022. The number of **arrivals** was 8.0 million.

“After a difficult start to the 2021/22 winter tourism season due to the nationwide lockdown in November/December 2021 and the rapid spread of the delta and omicron variants of the coronavirus, nights spent picked up again from February 2022. Overall, the past winter season with 52.66 million nights spent was therefore significantly more positive than the previous winter season, which was almost completely cancelled due to the Corona pandemic. Nevertheless, the number of nights spent was 27.8% below the level of the comparable period before the Corona crisis,” said Statistics Austria Director General Tobias Thomas.

Accordingly, this year's winter season was still 20.26 million nights spent short of the previously strongest winter season 2018/19 (72.92 million). Foreign guests accounted for three quarters of all nights spent in the winter season 2021/22 (39.73 million).

In **April 2022**, 7.54 million nights spent and 2.30 million arrivals were recorded.
