Industrial producer prices rose by 20.9 % in May 2022

Compared to April 2022, the index increased by 0.4 %

Vienna, 2022-06-30 – The industrial producer price index, IPPI 2021, reached 117.8 points in May 2022, representing a price increase of 20.9 % compared to May 2021, as Statistics Austria reports. In April and March 2022, the annual rates of change had been +21.6 % and +21.2 %, respectively. Between April and May 2022, the industrial producer price index rose by 0.4 %.

The increase of the industrial producer price index in May 2022 (+20.9 %) was mainly due to increasing prices in the energy sector (+50.1 %). The prices for intermediate goods moved up by 19.5 % compared to May 2021. Prices for consumer goods went up by 6.4 %, those for capital goods increased by 4.3 %.
