Production index was up by 4.6 % in June 2022

This increase can particularly be traced back to the energy sector

Vienna, 2022-08-10 – The working-day adjusted production index for industries and construction (ÖNACE 2008 B–F) increased by 4.6 % in June 2022 compared to June of the previous year, according to calculations by Statistics Austria. Compared to May 2022, it decreased by 2.1 % (seasonally adjusted).

In comparison with the **previous month May 2022**, the seasonally adjusted (EU-harmonized) industrial production (ÖNACE 2008 B–E) was down by 1.2 % in June 2022. Compared to May 2022, the main industrial groupings (MIG) showed the following results: capital goods +2.7 %, consumer durables +1.1 %, consumer non-durables -2.7 %, intermediate goods -3.0 %, energy -7.7 % (see table 1).

In **year-on-year** comparison, the working-day adjusted (EU-harmonised) industrial production index (ÖNACE 2008 B–E) reached 130.0 points in June 2022 and was up by 8.6 % on the result of June 2021. The working-day adjusted production in construction decreased by 6.9 % compared to the previous year. Regarding the year-on-year change the main industrial groupings (MIG) were subject to the following developments: energy +17.0 %, capital goods +11.6 %, consumer durables +7.4 %, intermediate goods +4.7 %, consumer non-durables +4.3 % (see table 1).

Several branches of the ÖNACE 2008 sections supported the positive development in industry compared to June of the last year. According to the current economic developments, the strong increase in the main industrial grouping of energy was due to electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply at +21.6 % and the extraction of crude oil and natural gas at +24.8 %.
