Industrial producer prices increased by 21.3 % in August 2022

Compared to July 2022, the index rose by 1.4 %

Vienna, 2022-09-30 – The industrial producer price index, IPPI 2021, reached 122.4 points in August 2022, representing a price increase of 21.3 % compared to August 2021, as Statistics Austria reports. In July and June 2022, the annual rates of change had been +20.7 % and +20.8 %, respectively. Compared to July 2022, the industrial producer price index rose by 1.4 %.

The increase of the industrial producer price index in August 2022 (+21.3 %) was mainly caused by rising prices in the energy sector (+59.7 %). The prices for intermediate goods increased by 14.4 % compared to August 2021. Prices for consumer goods went up by 7.4 % and those for capital goods by 4.4 %.
