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Production index was up by 3.9 % in October 2022

Constantly moderate increase in the construction sector

Vienna, 2022-12-09 – The working-day adjusted production index for industries and construction (ÖNACE 2008 B–F) increased by 3.9 % in October 2022 compared to October of the previous year, according to calculations by Statistics Austria. Compared to September 2022, it decreased by 0.6 % (seasonally adjusted).

In comparison with the **previous month September 2022**, the seasonally adjusted (EU-harmonized) industrial production (ÖNACE 2008 B–E) was down by 0.9 % in October 2022. Compared to September 2022, the main industrial groupings (MIG) showed the following results: consumer non-durables +0.8 %, intermediate goods +0.3 %, consumer durables -0.8 %, capital goods -2.1 %, energy -4.4 % (see table 1).

In a **year-on-year** comparison, the working-day adjusted (EU-harmonised) industrial production index (ÖNACE 2008 B–E) reached 131.7 points in October 2022 and was up by 4.3 % on the result of October 2021. The working-day adjusted production in construction increased by 2.6 % compared to the previous year. Regarding the year-on-year change the main industrial groupings (MIG) were subject to the following developments: consumer durables +7.4 %, intermediate goods +6.3 %, capital goods +4.5 %, consumer non-durables +3.7 %, energy -0.5 % (see table 1).

Compared to the previous year the construction sector increased moderately and stayed constant according to the development of the recent periods. While civil engineering rose by 12.4% to 160.9 points, the building construction grew by 1.0% to 143.4 points.
