Production up by 3.9 % in November 2022

Since summer upward trend in manufacure of machinery and equipment

Vienna, 2023-01-10 – The working-day adjusted production index for industries and construction (ÖNACE 2008 B–F) increased by 3.9 % in November 2022 compared to November of the previous year, according to calculations by Statistics Austria. Compared to October 2022, it increased by 0.3 % (seasonally adjusted).

In comparison with the **previous month October 2022**, the seasonally adjusted (EU-harmonized) industrial production (ÖNACE 2008 B–E) was up by 0.2 % in November 2022. Compared to October 2022, the main industrial groupings (MIG) showed the following results: capital goods +6,7 %, consumer durables +3.9 %, consumer non-durables +0.5 %, intermediate goods -1.0 %, energy -2.7 % (see table 1).

In a **year-on-year** comparison, the working-day adjusted (EU-harmonised) industrial production index (ÖNACE 2008 B–E) reached 137.1 points in November 2022 and was up by 4.5 % on the result of November 2021. The working-day adjusted production in construction increased by 2.3 % compared to the previous year. Regarding the year-on-year change the main industrial groupings (MIG) were subject to the following developments: consumer durables +16.9 %, capital goods +9.7 %, energy +3.2 %, consumer nondurables +2.9 %, intermediate goods -0.7 % (see table 1).

Several branches of the ÖNACE 2008 sections supported the positive development in industry compared to November of the last year. The strong increase in the main industrial grouping of capital goods was due to the manufacure of machinery and equipment with +16.1 % to 153.1 points and the manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers with +15.8 %.
