More marriages, less divorces in 2022

More registered partnerships established and dissolved

Vienna, 2023-02-20 – According to preliminary results from Statistics Austria, a total of 46 415 marriages were concluded in 2022 and 1 585 registered partnerships were established. During the same period, a total of 13 493 divorces and 139 dissolutions of registered partnerships took place.

"After two years in which many private plans were thwarted by corona-related restrictions, about as many couples said I do again in 2022 as in the pre-crisis year 2019. At the same time, the number of divorces declined: compared to 2021, 7.0 % fewer marriages were legally divorced, and compared to 2019, there were even 17.3 % fewer divorces," says Tobias Thomas, Director General of Statistics Austria.

The preliminary number of 46 415 marriages in 2022 was thus 5 304 or 12.9 % higher than in 2021, but only 0.8 % higher than in 2019, the last pre-Corona year. There were also 1 585 registered partnerships established in 2022, 184 or 13.1 % more than the year before. Compared to 2019, the increase was 24.9 %.

In contrast, 13 493 marriages were legally divorced in 2022, 1 017 or 7.0 % less than in the previous year and 17.3 % less than in 2019. At the same time, 139 registered partnerships were dissolved, up 28 % or 25.2 % from 2021 and 14.9 % more than in 2019.

In 2022, a total of 780 couples – 337 male and 443 female – took advantage of the possibility of same-sex marriage, which has existed since 1 January 2019. At the same time, 1 481 opposite-sex couples and 104 same-sex couples established a registered partnership. The preliminary data for 2022 also include 30 conversions from registered partnerships into marriages.

According to the preliminary results, more marriages took place in all provinces in 2022 than in the previous year. The largest increases were registered in Carinthia (+19.2 %), followed by Burgenland (+16.1 %), Lower Austria (+15.6 %), Styria (+14.9 %), Tyrol (+13.7 %) and Salzburg (+13.5 %).

The preliminary number of registered partnerships also increased in all federal provinces in 2022. The most significant increases compared to the previous year were recorded in Salzburg (+27.5 %), followed by Burgenland (+25.8 %), Lower Austria (+17.5 %), and Styria (+14.1 %) and Vorarlberg (+13.8 %).

With the exception of Burgenland (+ 0.7 %), fewer marriages were legally divorced in 2022 than in the previous year. The strongest decreases were recorded in Vienna (-12.0 %), followed by Vorarlberg (-11.2 %), Tyrol (-10.4 %) and Upper Austria (-7.7 %).

Dissolutions of registered partnerships for subsequent marriages are not included in the statistics. However, their number can be read from the number of conversions of registered partnerships into marriages. In 2022, 46 same-sex marriages were divorced and 58 opposite-sex partnerships were dissolved. – 1) Including 625 marriages divorced abroad and 7 registered partnerships dissolved abroad of persons with their main residence in Austria.

Information on methodology, definitions: Marriages, dissolutions of marriages and registered partnerships also include events abroad of persons whose main residence is in Austria. Marriages, dissolutions of marriages and dissolutions of registered partnerships of persons residing abroad that take place in Austria are not included.

The regional classification of the published data is based either on the couple's common place of residence or, in the case of separate places of residence, on the man's place of residence in the case of opposite-sex couples or on the place of residence of the older person in the case of same-sex couples. Preliminary results for 2022 include all information submitted by January 31, 2023.
