Production up by 1.0% in April 2023

Continuous increase of capital goods compared to the previous year

Vienna, 2023-06-09 – In April 2023, the working-day adjusted production index for industries and construction increased by 1.0% compared to April of the previous year, according to calculations by Statistics Austria. Compared to March 2023, it increased by 0.9% (seasonally adjusted).

In comparison with the **previous month March 2023**, the seasonally adjusted (EU-harmonised) industrial production (ÖNACE 2008 B–E) increased by 1.0% in April 2023. Compared to March 2023, the main industrial groupings (MIG) showed the following results: energy +11.5%, capital goods +0.3%, intermediate goods -1.0%, consumer non-durables -1.9%, consumer durables -8.5% (see table 1).

In a **year-on-year** comparison, the working-day adjusted (EU-harmonised) industrial production index (ÖNACE 2008 B–E) reached 127.6 points in April 2023 and was therefore 1.3% above the result of April 2022. The working-day adjusted production in construction decreased by 0.2% compared to the previous year. Regarding the year-on-year change the main industrial groupings (MIG) were subject to the following developments: capital goods +6.7%, energy +5.5%, consumer non-durables +3.2%, consumer durables +2.7%, intermediate goods -4.5% (see table 1).

Except for the intermediate goods, the production development of the main industrial groupings showed positive results compared to the previous year. The increase of the capital goods could in particular be traced back to manufacture of machinery and equipment (ÖNACE 28) with a plus of 5.6% and to manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (ÖNACE 29) with a plus of 12.0% and continued its growth of the past months.
