Production down by 3.4% in June 2023

Production in construction declined, plus in civil engineering, minus in building construction

Vienna, 2023-08-10 – The working-day adjusted production index for industries and construction decreased by 3.4% in June 2023 compared to June of the previous year, according to calculations by Statistics Austria. Compared to May 2023, it decreased by 1.4% (seasonally adjusted).

In comparison with the **previous month May 2023**, the seasonally adjusted (EU-harmonised) industrial production (ÖNACE 2008 B–E) decreased by 2.0% in June 2023. Compared to May 2023, the main industrial groupings (MIG) showed the following results: consumer non-durables 0,0%, capital goods –1.3%, intermediate goods –1.3%, consumer durables –2.8%, energy –6.6% (see table 1).

In a **year-on-year** comparison, the working-day adjusted (EU-harmonised) industrial production index (ÖNACE 2008 B–E) reached 126.0 points in June 2023 and was therefore 3.4% under the result of June 2022. The working-day adjusted production in construction decreased by 3.3% compared to the previous year. Regarding the year-on-year change the main industrial groupings (MIG) were subject to the following developments: consumer non-durables +6,8%, capital goods –0.3%, energy –2.6%, consumer durables –6.7%, intermediate goods –8.5% (see table 1).

While the production in construction fell noticeably in May 2023 in both building construction and civil engineering, the civil engineering increased again in June 2023 with +4.8% compared to the previous year, whereas building construction maintained its downward trend with –11.5%.
