# Production down by 3.9% in June 2024

## Industry hit harder by decline than construction

Vienna, 2024-08-09 – In June 2024, the working day adjusted production index for industry and construction sector decreased by 3.9% compared to June of the previous year, according to calculations by Statistics Austria. Compared to May 2024, it decreased by 0.7% (seasonally adjusted).

“The downward trend in industrial production has been continuing for a year now and dominates the development of Austrian production as a whole. The 4.9% drop in industrial production in June clearly continues this trend. Production was lower in manufacture of machinery and equipment, the manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers and the manufacture of electrical equipment in particular,” says Statistics Austria General Director Tobias Thomas.

Compared to **June of the previous year**, the working day adjusted production index in industry fell by 4.9% to 103.7 points in June 2024. The working day adjusted production in construction decreased by 0.6% compared to the previous year. Regarding the year-on-year change the main industrial groupings (MIG) were subject to the following developments: energy +0.7%, consumer non-durables –2.0%, intermediate goods –3.6%, capital goods –7.6%, consumer durables –17.6% (see table 1).

In comparison with the **previous month May 2024**, the seasonally adjusted industrial production decreased by 1.0%, while the construction output increased by 0.4% in June 2024. Compared to May 2024, the main industrial groupings (MIG) showed the following results: consumer durables +1.3%, energy +1.2%, capital goods –0.1%, intermediate goods –0.4%, consumer non-durables –0.8% (see table 1).
