Almost 40 million nights spent in the first half of the summer season 2024

Best result for May to July since 1980

Vienna, 2024-09-04 – According to preliminary results from Statistics Austria, 39.94 million nights spent in Austrian accommodation establishments were reported for the first half of the 2024 summer tourism season (May to July). This was 0.8% above the previous year's level.

“In the first half of the ongoing summer season 2024 holidays in Austria were more in demand than ever before. With 39.94 million nights spent, the best result in the period May to July was achieved since 1980. About 70% of these nights spent are attributable to guests from abroad,” says Statistics Austria Director General (responsible for Statistics) Tobias Thomas.

Summer season to date achieved best result since 1980

In the **2024 summer season to date (May to July)**, 39.94 million nights spent were recorded, an increase of 0.8% compared to the same period of the previous year (39.50 million). Non-resident guests contributed with 27.96 million nights spent (+1.2%) to the positive interim result. Nights spent by resident guests remained unchanged at 11.98 million.

18.67 million nights spent in July 2024

In July 2024, a total of 18.67 million nights spent were recorded in Austria, which corresponds to -0.7% compared to July 2023. Nights spent by non-resident guests decreased by 0.7% to 13.81 million, while nights spent by residents fell by 0.6% to 4.87 million.

An analysis by country of origin shows that nights spent by guests from Germany (-1.8%), Czech Republic (-6.0%) and Belgium (-2.1%) declined. Increases were recorded by guests from the Netherlands (+0.2%), Switzerland and Liechtenstein (+0.8%).

Second-highest result ever recorded in calendar year to date

In the **calendar year 2024 to date (January to July)**, 94.44 million nights spent were recorded, 1.17 million more (+1.2%) than in the same period of the previous year. Since the beginning of statistical records, 2019 was the only year with more nights spent in this period (95.10 million). In terms of arrivals, 27.38 million guests (+2.9%) were recorded, of which 19.07 million were non-resident guests and 8.31 million were resident guests.
