Winter season 2024/25 starts with 5.5 million nights spent

141.6 million nights spent from January to November 2024

Vienna, 2025-01-03 – In November 2024, the first month of the 2024/25 winter tourism season, 5.52 million nights spent were reported in Austrian accommodation establishments, the highest figure ever recorded, according to preliminary results from Statistics Austria. This is 6.7% more than in November 2023 (5.18 million).

“The Austrian winter tourism season 2024/25 kicks off with an all-time high. A total of 5.52 million nights spent were recorded, marking the highest November value ever registered. Compared to November 2023, Vienna experienced a particular strong increase in nights spent with a growth of 12.3%,” says Statistics Austria Director General Tobias Thomas.

November 2024: 6.7% more nights spent than in the previous year

In **November 2024** an increase in nights spent by 6.7% to 5.52 million was achieved compared to November 2023. The number of nights spent by guests from abroad rose by 5.9% to 3.20 million, while the number of nights spent by resident guests increased by 7.8% to 2.32 million. The number of guest arrivals in Austrian tourism accommodation increased by 7.9% year-on-year to 2.23 million.

Nights spent in current calendar year above previous year

At 141.64 million nights spent, **the 2024 calendar year to date** (January to November) is 1.3 % above the result for the same period in the previous year. To reach the previous year's total (151.17 million), about 10 million nights spent are needed. By comparison, in last year's December, 11.41 million nights spent were reported. The number of nights spent by guests from abroad was 1.6% higher than in the same period of the previous year and reached 103.92 million, while guests from Austria spent 37.72 million nights in Austrian accommodation establishments (+0.8%).
