
Reporting Obligations


In 2021, a total of 48 282 enterprises had to report data for one or more surveys conducted by Statistics Austria. In comparison to 2020, the number of enterprises with reporting obligations decreased by 295, basically because in 2021 a quadrennial labor cost survey was performed affecting more enterprises than the biennial survey on research and development performed in 2020. Moreover, a new survey – the survey on wholesale prices – was included to our monitoring system in 2021.

57.0 % of the enterprises with reporting obligations had reporting obligations for one survey only, 24.9 % for two and 18.1 % for 3 or more. The maximum number of reporting obligations was ten, affecting only three enterprises. The total number of enterprises with reporting obligations was 9.6 % of all active enterprises. The total response burden for all compulsory surveys conducted by Statistics Austria was about 757 200 hours in 2021, about 2.5 % more than in 2020.
