Number of deaths increases again

Vienna, 2021-03-25 – According to preliminary results by Statistics Austria, 1 754 people died in Austria in calendar week 10 (from 8 to 14 March 2021).

"The trend of continuously decreasing number of deaths since the end of January ended after seven weeks by the second week of March: In the 10th calendar week, 1 754 persons died, which was 175 more than in the previous week and 1.2% more deaths than the five-year average of the comparable week", said Statistics Austria Director General Tobias Thomas.
